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### About The NCS™

The National Community Survey<sup>TM</sup> (The NCS<sup>TM</sup>) report is about the "livability" of Sedona. A livable community is a place that is not simply habitable, but that is desirable. It is not only where people do live, but where they want to live. The survey was developed by the experts from National Research Center at Polco.

Great communities are partnerships of the government, private sector, community-based organizations and residents, all geographically connected. The NCS captures residents' opinions considering ten central facets of a community:

- Economy
- Mobility
- Community Design
- Utilities
- Safety
- Natural Environment
- Parks and Recreation
- Health and Wellness
- Education, Arts, and Culture
- Inclusivity and Engagement

The report provides the opinions of a representative sample of 652 residents of the City of Sedona collected from September 5, 2022 to November 3, 2022. The margin of error around any reported percentage is 4% for all respondents and the response rate for the 2022 survey was 25%. Survey results were weighted so that the demographic profile of respondents was representative of the demographic profile of adults in Sedona.





### How the results are reported

For the most part, the percentages presented in the following tabs represent the "percent positive." Most commonly, the percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, etc.). On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data." However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in most of the tabs. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

### Comparisons to benchmarks

NRC's database of comparative resident opinion is comprised of resident perspectives gathered in surveys from over 600 communities whose residents evaluated the same kinds of topics on The National Community Survey. The comparison evaluations are from the most recent survey completed in each community in the last five years. NRC adds the latest results quickly upon survey completion, keeping the benchmark data fresh and relevant. The communities in the database represent a wide geographic and population range. In each tab, Sedona's results are noted as being "higher" than the benchmark, "lower" than the benchmark, or "similar" to the benchmark, meaning that the average rating given by Sedona residents is statistically similar to or different (greater or lesser) than the benchmark. Being rated as "higher" or "lower" than the benchmark means that Sedona's average rating for a particular item was more than 10 points different than the benchmark. If a rating was "much higher" or "much lower," then Sedona's average rating was more than 20 points different when compared to the benchmark.

The survey was administered during the COVID-19 pandemic, a time of challenge for many local governments. While we provide comparisons to national benchmarks, it is important to note that much of the benchmark data was collected prior to the pandemic. This may impact how your City's 2022 ratings compare to other communities' ratings from the past five years.

### Trends over time

Trend data for Sedona represent important comparison data and should be examined for improvements or declines\*. Deviations from stable trends over time represent opportunities for understanding how local policies, programs, or public information may have affected residents' opinions. Changes between survey years have been noted with an arrow and the percent difference. If the difference is greater than six percentage points between the 2020 and 2022 surveys, the change is statistically significant.

\* In 2020, The NCS survey was updated to include new and refreshed items. Consequently, some of the trends may be impacted due to wording modifications that could have potentially altered the meaning of the item for the respondent.

### Methods

### Selecting survey recipients

All households within the City of Sedona were eligible to participate in the survey. A list of all households within the zip codes serving Sedona was purchased from Go-Dog Direct based on updated listings from the United States Postal Service. Since some of the zip codes that serve the City of Sedona households may also serve addresses that lie outside of the community, the exact geographic location of each housing unit was compared to community boundaries using the most current municipal boundary file. Addresses located outside of the City of Sedona boundaries were removed from the list of potential households to survey. From that list, addresses were randomly selected as survey recipients, with multi-family housing units (defined as those with a unit number) sampled at a rate of 5:3 compared to single family housing units.

An individual within each household was selected using the birthday method. The birthday method selects a person within the household by asking the "person whose birthday has most recently passed" to complete the questionnaire. The underlying assumption in this method is that day of birth has no relationship to the way people respond to surveys. This instruction was contained in the introduction of the survey.

### **Conducting the survey**

The 2,800 randomly selected households received mailings beginning on September 15, 2022 and the survey remained open for seven weeks. The first mailing was a postcard inviting the household to participate in the survey. The next mailing contained a cover letter with instructions, the survey questionnaire, and a postage-paid return envelope. All mailings included a web link to give residents the opportunity to respond to the survey online. All follow-up mailings asked those who had not completed the survey to do so and those who had already done so to refrain from completing the survey again.

About 8% of the 2,800 mailed invitations or surveys were returned because the household address was vacant or the postal service was unable to deliver the survey as addressed. Of the remaining 2,568 households that received the invitations to participate,652 completed the survey, providing an overall response rate of 25%. The response rate was calculated using AAPOR's response rate #2\* for mailed surveys of unnamed persons.

It is customary to describe the precision of estimates made from surveys by a "level of confidence" and accompanying "confidence interval" (or margin of error). A traditional level of confidence, and the one used here, is 95%. The 95% confidence interval can be any size and quantifies the sampling error or imprecision of the survey results because some residents' opinions are relied on to estimate all residents' opinions. The margin of error for the City of Sedona survey is no greater than plus or minus four percentage points around any given percent reported for all respondents (652 completed surveys).

In addition to the randomly selected "probability sample" of households, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Sedona. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it included a question to confirm that the respondent was a Sedona resident and a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on October 20. The survey remained open for twoweeks. The data presented in the following tabs exclude the open participation survey data, but a tab at the end provides the complete frequency of responses to questions by the open participation respondents.

### Analyzing the data

Responses from mailed surveys were entered into an electronic dataset using a "key and verify" method, where all responses are entered twice and compared to each other. Any discrepancies were resolved in comparison to the original survey form. Range checks as well as other forms of quality control were also performed. Responses from surveys completed on Polco were downloaded and merged with the mailed survey responses.

The demographics of the survey respondents were compared to those found in the 2010 Census and 2020 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the City of Sedona. The primary objective of weighting survey data is to make the survey respondents reflective of the larger population of the community. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.\* The results of the weighting scheme for the probability sample are presented in the following table.

NRC aligns demographic labels with those used by the U.S. Census for reporting purposes, when possible. Some categories (e.g., age, race/Hispanic origin, housing type, and length of residency) are combined into smaller subgroups.

The survey datasets were analyzed using all or some of a combination of the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), R, Python and Tableau. For the most part, the percentages presented in the reports represent the "percent positive." The percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, essential/very important, etc.), or, in the case of resident behaviors/participation, the percent positive represents the proportion of respondents indicating "yes" or participating in an activity at least once a month.

On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data". However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in the reports. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

### **Key Findings**

### While there have been small gains in the local economy, it remains an area of opportunity.

Ratings for the economy in Sedona have made some progress since the survey in 2020, with the vibrancy of uptown/commercial areas (66%) and shopping opportunities (35%) both increasing by 9% since the previous survey. While Sedona as a place to work remained stable from 2020, with about one-third of residents offering positive, employment opportunities rose from 22% positive ratings to 35% this year. Roughly 4 in 10 residents offered high marks for the variety of business and service establishments, and about 6 in 10 gave similar ratings for the overall quality of business and service establishments, a 9% decline from 2020. Cost of living remains an area of focus, with just one in 10 residents offering positive ratings, scoring lower than national benchmarks. The majority of residents provided positive ratings of Sedona as a place to visit. However, in a question unique to Sedona's survey, residents were asked how much of a role they would like to see tourism have in Sedona's economy, with about 6 in 10 reporting they would like to see less of a role in the future, and about one-third reporting that it should stay about the same.

### Ratings for mobility reflect both successes and challenges.

While a few aspects of mobility remained below the national averages, ratings for some aspects of mobility have improved. About one third of residents offered high marks for overall quality of the transportation system, lower than national comparison group, but rose 10% from the survey in 2020. Ease of travel by public transportation (24%) and ease of travel by bicycle (46%) both saw similar gains from the previous survey. Sedona's transportation services were generally on par with the national averages, with about 7 in 10 residents giving positive ratings for street cleaning and lighting, and sidewalk maintenance. Around 4 in 10 residents gave high marks to traffic enforcement and signal timing, as well as bus or transit services. In another question unique to Sedona, residents were asked if they would support the expansion of bicycle and pedestrian paths to create city wide connectivity, with more than 8 in 10 residents reporting that they would strongly or somewhat support the expansion.

### Residents raise concerns about community design and housing.

Ratings for community design in Sedona were generally rated below national averages, indicating that this facet may be an area of opportunity. The majority of residents offered high marks for their neighborhood as a place to live (88%) and overall appearance (73%), on par with national comparison groups. About 4 in 10 residents gave positive ratings for the overall design or layout of residential and commercial areas, well-designed neighborhoods, and public places where people want to spend time, scoring lower than national averages. Well-planned residential growth and overall quality of new development were given positive ratings by just 2 in 10 residents, scoring much lower than national benchmarks. Residents ratings for the variety of housing options and availability of affordable quality housing indicate that these may be the biggest areas of opportunity, with less than 1 in 10 residents providing positive ratings, scoring much lower than the national benchmarks.

### While the City's safety services receive positive ratings, residents show concerns about natural disasters.


Sedona's safety ratings tended to be positive overall, and continue to be a strength in the community. About 9 in 10 residents offered high marks for the overall feeling of safety, and feeling safe in their neighborhood and uptown/commercial areas during the day. A similar proportion reported feeling safe from property crime and violent crime, both scoring higher than national averages. Ratings for Sedona's safety services were positive and on par with national averages. Around three-quarters of residents gave positive reviews of the Police services, crime prevention, and ambulance or emergency medical services. Fire services were given high marks from 9 in 10 residents, but just 6 in 10 reported feeling safe from fire, flood, or other natural disaster. In another question unique to Sedona's survey, residents were asked if they had prepared for a natural disaster emergency. Roughly 7 in 10 residents reported that they had signed up for emergency alerts. About half of respondents reported that they had reviewed the City's Emergency Preparedness Guide and strengthened their home. A similar proportion reported that they had made a plan for their pets, created a home inventory, or created a "Go Bag".

### **Facets of livability**

Resident perceptions of quality and importance for each of the facets of community livability provide an overview of community strengths and challenges that are useful for planning, budgeting and performance evaluation.

The charts below show the proportion of residents who rated the community facets positively for quality and the priority (importance) placed on each. Also displayed is whether local ratings were lower, similar, or higher than communities across the country (the national benchmark).


### **Balancing performance and importance**

Every jurisdiction must balance limited resources while meeting resident needs and striving to optimize community livability. To this end, it is helpful to know what aspects of the community are most important to residents and which they perceive as being of higher or lower quality. It is especially helpful to know when a facet of livability is considered of high importance but rated as lower quality, as this should be a top priority to address.

To help guide City staff and officials with decisions on future resource allocation, resident ratings of the importance of services were compared to their ratings of the quality of these services. To identify the services perceived by residents to have relatively lower quality at the same time as relatively higher importance, all services were ranked from highest perceived quality to lowest perceived quality and from highest perceived importance to lowest perceived importance. Some services were in the top half of both lists (higher quality and higher importance); some were in the top half of one list but the bottom half of the other (higher quality and lower importance or lower quality and higher importance); and some services were in the bottom half of both lists.


Services receiving quality ratings of excellent or good by 56% or more of respondents were considered of "higher quality" and those with ratings lower than 56% were considered to be of "lower quality." Services were classified as "more important" if they were rated as essential or very important by 77% or more of respondents. Services were rated as "less important" if they received a rating of less than 77%. This classification uses the median ratings for quality and importance to divide the services in half.

The quadrants in the figure below show which community facets were given higher or lower importance ratings (right-left) and which had higher or lower quality ratings (up-down). Facets of livability falling closer to a diagonal line from the lower left to the upper right are those where performance ratings are more commensurate with resident priorities. Facets scoring closest to the lower right hand corner of the matrix (higher in importance and lower in quality) are those that may warrant further investigation to see if changes to their delivery are necessary to improve their performance. This is the key part of this chart on which to focus. Facets falling in the top left hand corner of the chart (lower in importance but higher in quality) are areas where performance may outscore resident priorities, and may be a consideration for lower resource allocation.



### **Quality of life**










What impact, if any, do you think the economy will have on your family income in the next 6 months? Do you think the impact will be:







### Overall quality of the utility infrastructure in Sedona, 2022



























# Methods (open participation)

As part of its participation in The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™), the City of Sedona conducted a survey of 646 residents. Survey invitations were mailed to randomly selected households and data were collected from September 15, 2022 to November 3, 2022. The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of your residents' opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Sedona. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it asked a question to confirm that the respondent was a Sedona resident and also a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on October 20, 2022. The survey remained open for two weeks and there were 286 responses.

The open participation survey data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of the survey; therefore, a level of confidence in the representativeness of the sample cannot be estimated. However, to reduce bias where possible, these data were statistically weighted to match the demographic characteristics of the 2010 Census and 2020 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the City of Sedona. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.\* The results of the weighting scheme for the open participation survey are presented in the following table.
